



Renewable Energy Desalination - Working Group Meeting Barcelona, April 24, 2012

The ProDes project created a working group on Renewable Energy Desalination. The aim of the group is to promote the use of desalination powered by renewable energy as an environmentally friendly and decentralised solution for sustainable water supply.
